#### How to register:

These are instructions for logging into our **New** registration site. This site is integrated with the DOE single log-in system, which means staff will no longer need to fill out long registration forms in order to sign up for PDs. ### Logging-In

Enter the following URL (<a href="https://tinyurl.com/pcsummerexpo">https://tinyurl.com/pcsummerexpo</a>) into your browser to reach the homepage. Make sure you are using the latest version of Internet explorer, Firefox, or Google Chrome for the best experience with the site.

In the "Email/Login ID" box, enter your DOE Email or the letters and numbers that come before @schools.nyc.gov in your DOE email address. For example, if your DOE email is <a href="mail/abc123@schools.nyc.gov">abc123@schools.nyc.gov</a>, you can enter the entire email address in the "Email/Login ID" box, or simply enter "abc123. You should enter the same password you use for your Microsoft Outlook DOE email login in the "Password" box.

# **Steps for Registration**

- The homepage has an information box located in the center of the user screen titled "Featured Training". Click directly on the training listed in this box as "Summer in the City Family Engagement." Don't worry that it says Special Education Office in the welcome message.
- 2. When you get to the Training Details page, click the "Request" button.
- 3. That's all you have to do! Your name, school, and contact information is already in the system. You will receive a confirmation email once you have successfully registered.
